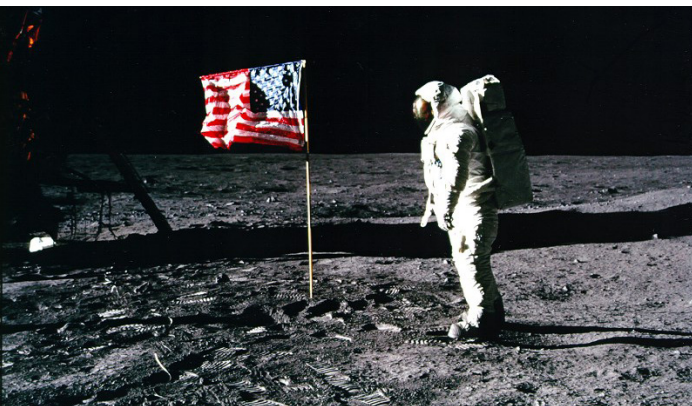


# Matching Pairs



The assassination (death) of the American President John F Kennedy in 1963 was broadcast on American television as he was visiting Dallas, Texas.

The wedding of Prince Charles and Lady Diana in 1981 was watched by 750 million people across the world.

The Apollo 11 moon landing in 1969 was watched by 500 million people across the world. Neil Armstrong became the first man to set foot on the moon.

Queen Elizabeth II's coronation in 1953 caused many British people to buy their first television set. 56% of British people watched the event live.

The Berlin Wall in 1989 was a wall that split Germany into two parts, separating families and causing many people to live in difficult conditions. Television coverage recorded German people gradually destroying the wall from the 9<sup>th</sup> November onwards.
