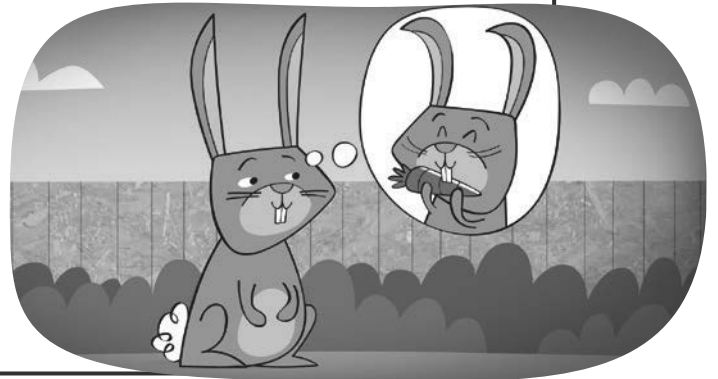

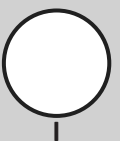
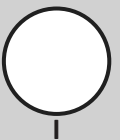

Sam digs in the soil. Dig ... dig ...



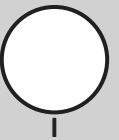
That is not a carrot!

3 What does Sam dig up first? Tick **one** box.

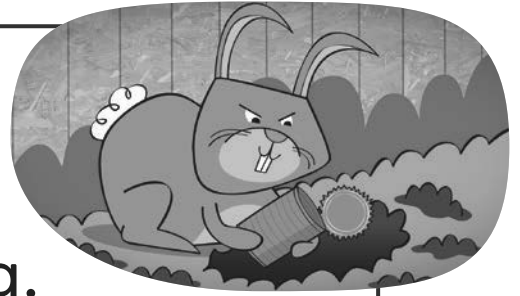
Carrots

He is fed up.

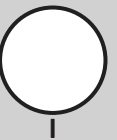


4 Why do you think Sam Rabbit is fed up? Tick **one** box.

He doesn't like carrots.

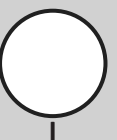
He has hurt his foot.

Sam will get his lunch now!

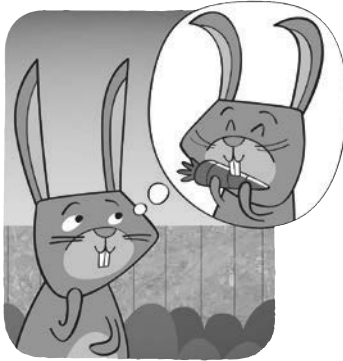
