PHONICS:

Next week we will be starting phonics sessions using Bug Club. The children will learn the first set of sounds which are: S, A, T, P. Once the children have learnt a sufficient number of sounds they will be issued with an eReading book and a physical book. More information on this will follow in the next week or two. If your child is already reading some books, please continue at home to supplement what we are doing in school.

MATHS:

Next week we will be focusing on numbers to 5, through songs, rhymes and activities.

LITERACY:

We will be reading stories about families and practising our pencil grip and control.

This week the children have continued to settle into their classes fantastically. It has been lovely to have all the children together and they have adapted to the higher numbers superbly.
