PHONICS:

The children will learn the next set of sounds which are: CK, E, U, R

MATHS:

We will be comparing amounts and using the language more, fewer and the same.

LITERACY:

Next week we will be using story maps and stepping stories as a way of retelling them and using the word 'because'.

The children have had a fantastic week and are now experts in 1, 2 and 3. We've talked a lot about what the numbers look like and the way they are written and how the children are able or learning to be able to subitise.
